



FAITC Facilitator Job Application:

Purpose of a FAITC facilitator: Have individuals represent FAITC to increase agricultural literacy in K-12 education in the state of Florida. This is achieved through conducting teacher workshops and collaborating with FAITC staff. An FAITC Facilitator seeks out opportunities to present workshops and presents on behalf of FAITC in their local areas.

Expectations/job overview of a FAITC facilitator:

- Attend facilitator training in the spring (dates/locations to come).
- Present or facilitate a minimum of three workshops per calendar year.
- Actively seek out trainings/ workshops for FAITC to have a presence at.
- Communicate with FAITC staff throughout the year.
- Submit facilitator proposal a minimum of two weeks in advance that includes agenda with FAITC materials used.
- Submit facilitator follow up and expense reimbursement forms two weeks after the event.
- Make contacts for FAITC in home county. Educational/school district contacts for help with the workshops and agriculture contacts for farm tour stops and technical support for teacher projects.
- Administrative tasks related to workshop located in home county.
