How the breed developed in the United States.

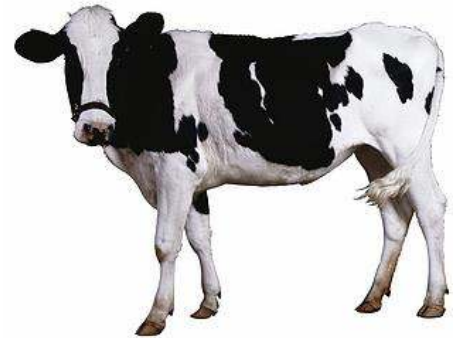
Milk Production Facts - What is the average milk production for the breed? What are the average percentages of protein and butterfat?
